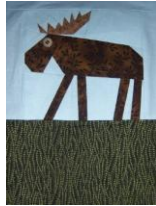


JANUARY 2010 BLOTTO



Have fun with this paper pieced UP Moose block designed by Jane Vandenburg. You may vary the size of the top and bottom pieces but remember that the finished size of the completed block with borders should be 8 ½" x 11". It can also be left slightly larger and let the winner of the blocks trim it down. Remember your block must be turned in at the February meeting.

Supplies:

- assorted brown fabrics for moose
- blue fabric for sky
- green fabric for grass
- all seams ¼"

Instructions:

- print pattern (see instructions below)
- paper piece each section and assemble them to form a 6 ½" square block
- sew a 2" strip of sky fabric to each side of the block
- sew a 1" to 2 ½" strip of sky fabric to the top of the block & vary size according to your taste
- sew a 3" to 5" strip of green fabric to the bottom of the block & vary size according to your taste but remember that the top and bottom borders must equal no less than 5 ½" to give you the finished size of 11"

Printing:

- click on the pattern here link which will open the pdf file
- in the upper left hand corner, hit the print icon which will open your printer. Be sure that the "page scale" is set to none
- print
- check to be sure that the pattern measures very close to 6" across the top or bottom of the block pieces
- if it doesn't measure 6" use your scanner or printer to adjust the size
